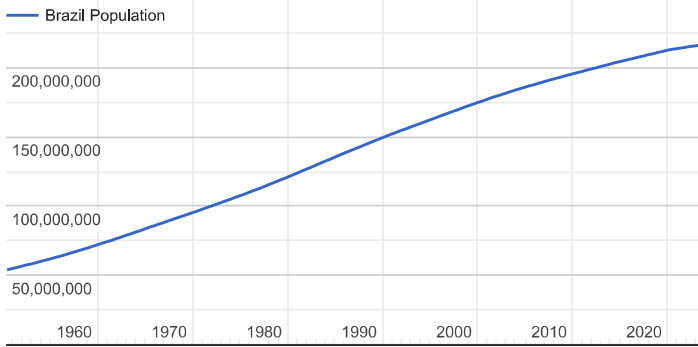

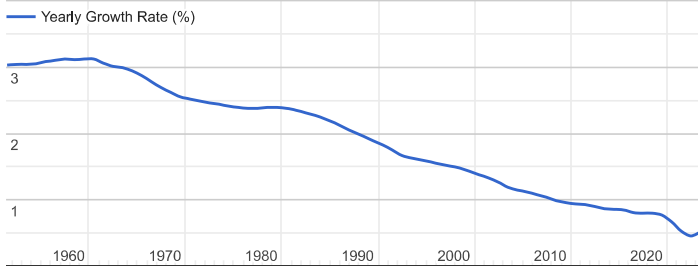

## Notes

The **Brazil Population (Live)** counter shows a continuously updated estimate of the current population of Brazil delivered by [Worldometer's RTS algorithm \(/licensing/what/\)](#), which processes data collected from the United Nations Population Division.

The **Population of Brazil (1950 - 2023)** chart plots the total population count as of July 1 of each year, from 1950 to 2023.

The **Yearly Population Growth Rate** chart plots the annual percentage changes in population registered on July 1 of each year, from 1951 to 2023. This value can differ from the *Yearly % Change* shown in the historical table, which shows the last year equivalent percentage change assuming homogeneous change in the preceding five year period.

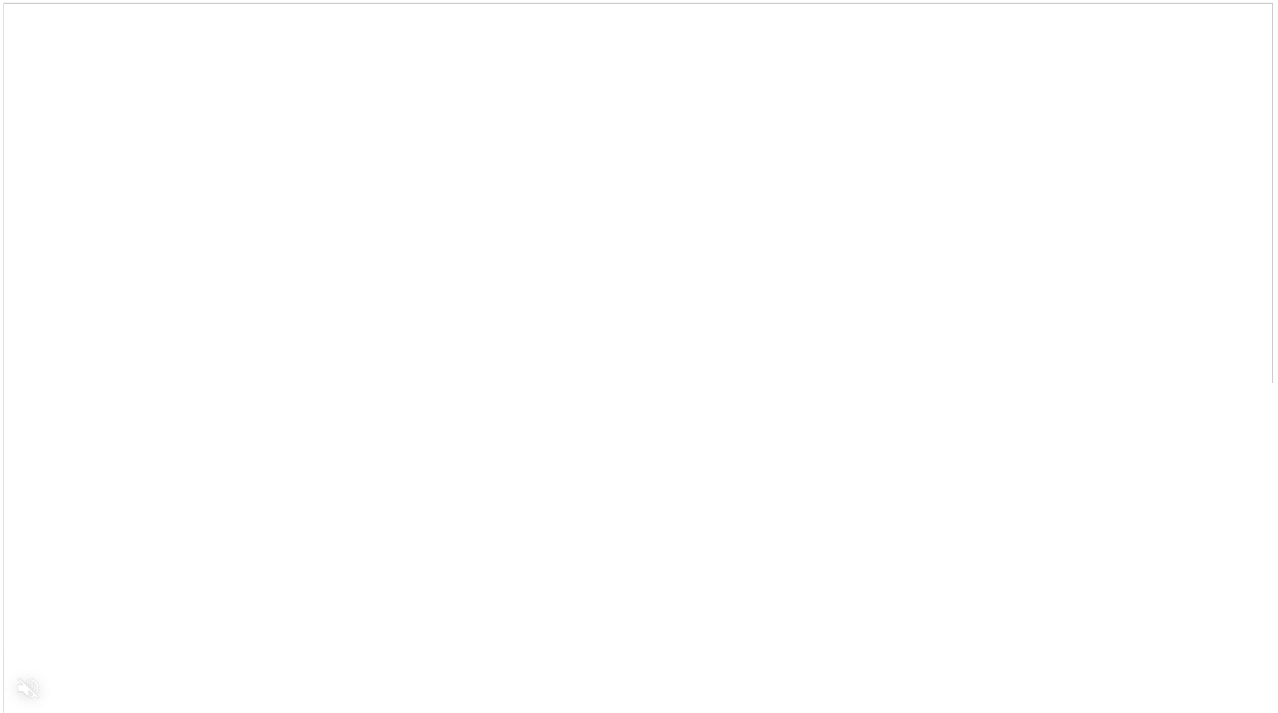
**Year:** as of July 1 of the year indicated.

**Population:** Overall total population (both sexes and all ages) in the country as of July 1 of the year indicated, as estimated by the United Nations, Department of Economic and Social Affairs, Population Division.
